1. **STATUTORY INFORMATION**

Redscan Cyber Security Limited is a private company, limited by shares, registered in England and Wales. The company's registered number and registered office address can be found on the Company Information page.

The presentation currency of the financial statements is the Pound Sterling (£).

2. **ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" including the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

The financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis. Other creditors include deferred income of £3,098,362 (2018: £1,805,335) which is not expected to result in any payment having to be made by the company. In the opinion of the directors, the company will be able to discharge its liabilities as and when they fall due in the foreseeable future, and therefore the going concern basis is reasonable.

Preparation of consolidated financial statements

The financial statements contain information about Redscan Cyber Security Limited as an individual company and do not contain consolidated financial information as the parent of a group. The company is exempt under Section 399(2A) of the Companies Act 2006 from the requirements to prepare consolidated financial statements.

Turnover

Turnover is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable, excluding discounts, rebates, value added tax and other sales taxes.

Revenue is recognised on the basis of the stage of the contract completion achieved, with a deferral made for the fair value of the undelivered element of the sale and a provision for income accrued but not yet invoiced. Revenue not recognised in the profit and loss account under this policy is classified as a creditor for deferred income or a debtor for accrued income on the balance sheet.

Intangible fixed assets

Intangible assets are initially measured at cost. Amortisation is provided at the following rate in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life less estimated residual value:

Website development and computer software - 3 years straight line

Development costs

Development expenditure is measured at cost and capitalised if it is probable that future economic benefits will flow to the company as a result of this expenditure. Otherwise it is written off to the profit and loss account in the year it is incurred.

Capitalised development expenditure is amortised over three years on a straight line basis to write it off over its estimated useful life.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its estimated useful life.

Plant and machinery etc - 33% on cost

Investments in subsidiaries

Investments in subsidiary undertakings are recognised at cost less impairment.

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES - continued

Taxation

Taxation for the year comprises current and deferred tax. Tax is recognised in the Income Statement, except to the extent that it relates to items recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity.

Current or deferred taxation assets and liabilities are not discounted.

Current tax is recognised at the amount of tax payable using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the balance sheet date.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Timing differences arise from the inclusion of income and expenses in tax assessments in periods different from those in which they are recognised in financial statements. Deferred tax is measured using tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the year end and that are expected to apply to the reversal of the timing difference.

Unrelieved tax losses and other deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that it is probable that they will be recovered against the reversal of deferred tax liabilities or other future taxable profits.

Research and development

Expenditure on research is written off in the year in which it is incurred.

Foreign currencies

Assets and liabilities in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rates of exchange ruling at the balance sheet date. Transactions in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rate of exchange ruling at the date of transaction. Exchange differences are taken into account in arriving at the operating result.

Hire purchase and leasing commitments

Rentals paid under operating leases are charged to profit or loss on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.

Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions payable to the company's pension scheme are charged to profit or loss in the period to which they relate.

11. CHANGE IN RECOGNITION OF RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT TAX CREDIT

The company has adopted a change in accounting policy with respect to the recognition of the research and development tax credit receivable for the year ending 31 December 2019. The credit is now recognised in the financial statements on an accruals basis and not the cash received basis which was adopted in the year ending 31 December 2018.

The directors believe the new policy matches income receivable with the related costs incurred and therefore presents a more accurate reflection of the company's financial position.

The effect of this change in accounting policy in the year ending 31 December 2019 is to reduce the loss after taxation for the year by £154,101. No adjustment has been made to prior years.
