

Revenues top €40 million at Cork-based Teamwork as firm tightens losses

The SaaS firm trimmed its after-tax losses from \$10.2 million in 2022 to \$9.6 million the next year

Revenues at Cork-based software company Teamwork rose 11.3 per cent to \$43.1 million (€40.8m) in 2023 as the firm managed to trim its losses.

The firm was founded in 2007 by Peter Coppinger and Daniel Mackey, with the former [stepping down as chief executive](#) in mid-October.
